This price includes the rental of a gravel pad for one camper, use of grounds, pool, game room, marina (not boat slips or boat rental), and pavilion for you and your children, grandchildren, parents, and grandparents. Each site has a picnic table. Electric is additional. Water for normal daily usage is included. Washing vehicles, boats, or campers is not considered normal daily usage.

Rules and Regulations

****Please note that this is not a complete list of rules.****

Office hours are from 9 AM to 5 PM.

All seasonal campsite, seasonal boat slip, and electric payments must be paid with cash or check. Credit and debit cards will not be accepted for payment.

Your campsite is for you and your immediate family members. This includes your spouse, children, grandchildren, parents and grandparents. Any additional family members or friends are considered guests and must pay a guest fee.

All vehicles on grounds must have a car pass. You will be provided with a seasonal car pass that is to be used by persons who signed the contract only. All family members and guests must stop in for a temporary car pass for each visit.

Quiet hours are from 11:00 PM to 7:00 AM
This will be strictly enforced.

No selling of campers, RVs, boat or other merchandise on grounds without permission of management. No display of signs, attempting to sell campers, boats, goods or services, advertisement of such services, or other distribution of written material without lakeside's approval. Lakeside will receive a 10% commission from any sales made on the grounds of lakeside whether it is posted by sign, newspaper advertised, internet advertised, or spread by word of mouth.

No fireworks or firearms allowed on grounds.

Gas powered golf carts are allowed, but you must purchase a permit and follow the permit rules. Handicap motorized vehicles are allowed at no charge.

Children must be accompanied by an adult on the marina, if they are under 12 they must wear a life jacket while on the dock. Children must be supervised by an adult at the swimming pool. No lifeguard on duty.

Management assumes no responsibility for loss by fire, theft, or accident.

Electric is read around the 15th of every month and can be paid at campground office.

No boats, jet skis, or boat trailers are to be parked at the campsite. A storage fee of \$150 for the season must be paid when leaving watercrafts behind. Seasonal boat slip renters are exempt from this fee. All boat and jet ski trailers must have owner's name or site # in a visible area on the tongue of the trailer.

Pets must be on a leash of 6 feet or less and under physical control at all times. You are required to clean up after your pets. Do not leave pets outside of the camper when you are gone. No pets in the bathhouse or pool area. No pit bulls or other vicious or aggressive dogs.

Camper must be set up on pad. Any changes to campsite must be approved by management. No building of decks. No outside/additional refrigerators.

It is the responsibility of the seasonal camper to inform all family and guests of Lakeside Campground's policies and ensure that they abide by them.

Becoming a seasonal camper

Please contact the office if you are interested in becoming a seasonal camper. The office will be able to provide current openings or put your name on a waiting list. If you are on the waiting list you will be called as soon as a seasonal campsite becomes open. You can also be put on the waiting list for the following season. We begin calling on that list the first week of January. There is no obligation from being put on the list.

Once you become a seasonal camper you will be required to have \$100,000 liability insurance on your camper.

The campground closes on October 31st at 2:00 PM. Your camper can be left on grounds for storage purposes only. The grounds are locked off and permission must be obtained from management for access to the grounds.

We send out seasonal letters mid December. At this time we will notify you of any changes that will affect you, including price changes. We do not know what the prices will be for the following year until this time. We will also remind you of the payment schedule and include the final amount owed on your electric.

Each year the contract for your site will automatically renew unless seasonal site prices are changed.

If at any time you wish to change sites your name will be put on a waiting list. Seasonal campers have first choice of sites when they become available.
